ARTHUR DONNELLY FISHER

Arthur Donnelly Wentworth Fisher was born at Lavender Bay on 14<sup>th</sup> December 1882, the son of Donnelly Fisher and his wife Genevieve Elizabeth, nee Lord. In May 1908 he was admitted as a solicitor having obtained his law degree from Sydney University.

Arthur was played First Class cricket between 1903 and 1908 including for NSW as a right handed batsman and medium-fast bowler.

On 11<sup>th</sup> August 1914 He joined the AN&MEF as a Lt, being a Lt in the cadets at the time of enlisting. He gave his father at 72 King St, Sydney as his next of kin and returned from Rabaul and was discharged, term expired, on 4<sup>th</sup> March 1915 having completed 206 days service.

Between enlisting and sailing, on 17<sup>th</sup> August, Arthur married Kathleen Millicent Palmer at St Thomas Church, North Sydney.

Arthur died at Neutral Bay on 9<sup>th</sup> July 1968.
