George was born at Woollahra on 24<sup>th</sup> December 1895, the son of George Corbett Butler and Mary Minnie Ashton.

He enlisted into F Company, AN&MEF on 11<sup>th</sup> August 1914 and stated that he was a plumber and was single. He gave his mother, at 29 Grosvenor St, Woollahra, as his next of kin.

George returned from Rabaul and was discharged, term expired, on 4<sup>th</sup> March 1915, having served 206 days.

On  $7^{th}$  March 1915, he enlisted in D Company,  $20^{th}$  Battalion, AIF, regimental number 1128, and was promoted corporal on  $31^{st}$  May 1915. He sailed with the Battalion for Suez on the BERRIMA, leaving Sydney on the  $26^{th}$  June 1915.

On 9<sup>th</sup> March 1916 he was taken on strength by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Pioneers and had a new regimental number, 1128A, assigned to him. He was promoted to sergeant on 14th March 1916 and transferred to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tunnelling Company on 14<sup>th</sup> June 1916, having moved with the Pioneers to France in March.

In July/August/September 1916 George spent a couple of months with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tunnelling Company before returning to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Pioneers. On 26<sup>th</sup> September 1917 he left the UK aboard the BORDA, arriving back in Australia on 25<sup>th</sup> November 1917. He was discharged as medically unfit, chronic synovitis of the knee, on 26<sup>th</sup> December 1917.

He tried to re-enlist on 5<sup>th</sup> May 1918 but was rejected on medical grounds.

In 1921 he married Marjory Dorothy Ann Dodwell and on 27<sup>th</sup> August 1942 he again enlisted and served in the LHQEME School until 13<sup>th</sup> Feb 1944, service number NX101777.

George died at Roseville in 1951.
