Frank was born in St Catherine's, London in 1886. On 11<sup>th</sup> August 1914 he enlisted in A Company, AN&MEF, stating that he was a barman and single, giving his father, James William Bond, 37 Pepys Rd, New Cross, London as his next of kin.

Frank returned fro Rabaul and was discharged, term expired, on 4<sup>th</sup> March 1915, having completed 206 days service.

On 28<sup>th</sup> September 1915 he again enlisted and was posted as an Acting Sergeant with D Coy Depot Battalion, transferring to C Coy, 19<sup>th</sup> Battalion from where he was discharged on 3<sup>rd</sup> Feb 1916 at the request of his wife. In his enlistment papers he listed his wife, May Bond, 398 Elizabeth Rd, Redfern as his next of kin.

On 24<sup>th</sup> June 1933 Frank died in The Western Suburbs Hospital from injuries received after being knock down by a motor vehicle. He is buried at Rookwood Cemetery. It is believed that Frank may have had a son, James Alexander Bond.
