Isidore was born in Sydney on 14<sup>th</sup> July 1876, the son of Maurice O'Connor Blake and Ellen N Blake, nee Loder. On 26<sup>th</sup> April 1899 Isidore married Pauline Mary White in Queensland.

On 11<sup>th</sup> August 1914 he enlisted in A Company, AN&MEF stating that he was a clerk, married, and gave his wife at 515 King St, Newtown, as his next of kin. He returned from Rabaul on the MATUNGA as a guard/escort for prisoners and was discharged as medically unfit (malaria) on 5<sup>th</sup> December 1914.

On 8<sup>th</sup> Jan 1915 he enlisted in A Company, 18<sup>th</sup> Battalion, regimental number 284, and saied for Suez with the Battalion aboard the CERAMIC, leaving Sydney on 25<sup>th</sup> June 1915. He landed on Gallipoli on 16<sup>th</sup> August and was evacuated to hospital on 22<sup>nd</sup> October suffering from Asthenia (a chronic wasting) and returned to the UK.

On  $17^{th}$  March 1916 he boarded the ASCANIUS for return to Australia where he was discharged on  $5^{th}$  October 1916 as medically unfit.

Isidore died on 6<sup>th</sup> March 1948 and is interred at Rookwood Cemetery.
