

Harold was born in Milton, NSW, in 1888, the son of Samuel Davey and Annie Davey, nee Addicoat. He was the elder brother of William Ellis Davey who also served in the AN&MEF, number 94. In 1913 he married Florence Elizabeth Lutherburrow at St Leonards, NSW.

On 11th August 1914 he joined the AN&MEF stating that he was a Tramway Conductor and gave his wife who was then living with her mother at New St, Willoughby, as his next of kin. He returned from Rabaul and was discharged, term expired, on 4th March 1915 having completed 206 days service.

On 22nd Jan 1917 he enlisted in the AIF, service number 3113 but only served 73 dys before being discharged on 12th March for unknown reasons.

Harold died at Willoughby on 6th February 1953.
