

George Barnes Dallas was born at Gunnedah, NSW, on 28th September 1891 the son of Charles Dallas and Mary Susannah Dallas, nee Barnes. On 11th August 1914 he joined H Company, AN&MEF, stating that he was a chainman and single and gave his mother at "Willowview", near Mundooran as his next of kin. During his time in Rabaul he contracted Malaria and spent time in the Military Hospital at Rabaul. He returned to Australia and was discharged, term expired, on 18th Jan 1915 having completed 161 days service.

On 25th June 1916 he joined the AIF, regimental number 35814 and shortly after married Alice Penson on 17th July. George was attached to the 2nd Depot Battalion at Cootamundra and was discharged as medically unfit with malaria on 25th September 1916 after having spent two months in hospital.

In 1951 he was fined a total of one pound, 18 shillings for failing to have a wireless licence as was required at that time.

George died as the result of an accident on 20th September 1959 and recorded as being a civil engineer at the time.
