

Frank was born at Balham, Surry on 4th Jan 1880, the son of George Kerr and Mary Ann Baulch. In 1908 he married Clara M Rutherford and he enlisted in the AN&MEF on 11th August 1914 stating that he was a cooper by trade and gave his wife, at Albion Street, Harris Park, Parramatta, as his next of kin. He further stated that he had previously spent a number of years on the School of Musketry Staff, Devon Regiment.

He was promoted to Sergeant on 18th August and returned from Rabaul and was discharged, term expired on 4th March 1915, having completed 206 days service.

On 22nd Feb 1916 he was taken on strength by the 34th Battalion as QM Sgt, and sailed with the Battalion aboard the HORORATA, leaving Sydney on 2nd May and arriving Plymouth on 23rd June 1916. He was appointed 2LT on 12th August and moved to France on 21st November.

On 25th Feb 1917 he was promoted Lt and to Captain on 7th November 1918.

Frank returned to Australia in June 1919 aboard the THERMISTOCLES and his appointment was terminated on 25th September 1919.

Frank died on 2nd Jan 1950 at Waverley and is buried at the Eastern Suburbs Memorial Park. He was survived by his wife, Clara and daughter Sara and her family.
