George enlisted in the AN&MEF on 11<sup>th</sup> August 1914 and was allocated to G Company. On his attestation papers he stated he was born in Sydney, was 24 years old, a shopkeeper and his next of kin was his mother, Mrs Theresa Clune, 17 Abercrombie St, Redfern, NSW. He stated he served 2 and a half years in the 33<sup>rd</sup> battalion Commonwealth Forces, being discharged because of illness.

George remained in the AN&MEF until 4<sup>th</sup> March 1915 when he was discharged, time expired, after serving 206 days.

In 1926, George married Gertrude (Bobbie) Dean and died on 14th July 1953, aged 64.

George is the younger brother of author, Frank Clune OBE, who also served in the AIF in World War 1.
